HOW CAN I PREPARE MY CHILD FOR PRIMARY 1?

Relating to others

1. Modelling the use of friendly and polite phrases

- “Hello! My name is... what is your name?”
- “May I please...”

2. Providing opportunities for your child to share and take turns during playtime with other children



HOW CAN I PREPARE MY CHILD FOR PRIMARY 1?

Routines help your child build confidence and learn to manage things by themselves.

Guide your child to do the following independently:

- Dress themselves
- Pack their stationery into pencil case
- Pack their books/items into school bag
- Knowing when and how to ask for help



HOW CAN I PREPARE MY CHILD FOR PRIMARY 1?

- **Nurturing positive learning attitudes**
 - Practise life skills independently like buying food and drinks on their own and asking for permission.



HOW CAN I PREPARE MY CHILD FOR PRIMARY 1?

- **Creating a conducive learning environment at home**
 - Have a dedicated area for learning
 - Establish a daily routine with your child, with time set aside for reading, schoolwork, rest, family time and play.
